# The Promise of a Blessing

## The 7 Blessings of Revelation



ere in the opening verses of the Book the Lord gives us the first of seven blessings contained in the Book. Throughout this prophecy we are encouraged to **READ** the word and to **KEEP** the commandments and to **DO** the commandments that we may receive the future blessing of being called into the Marriage Supper of the Lamb.

1. Revelation 1:3 “Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written in it; for the time is near.”
2. Revelation 14:13 “Then I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, "Write: 'Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on.' "Yes," says the Spirit, "that they may rest from their labors, and their works follow them.”
3. Revelation 16:15 “Behold, I am coming as a thief. Blessed is he who watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walks naked and they see his shame.”
4. Revelation 19:9 “Then he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!' "And he said to me, "These are the true sayings of God.”
5. Revelation 20:6 “Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years.”
6. Revelation 22:7 “... blessed is he who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book.”
7. Revelation 22:14 “Blessed are those who do His commandments, that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter through the gates into the city.”





# Introduction



few days before His death, as Jesus sat on the Mount of Olives, He gave many prophecies of futuristic events precluding His return (Mark 13: 1-31). In regards as to when these things will happen Jesus replied:

Mark 13:32, “but of that day and that hour no man knows, no, not the angels in heaven, neither the Son, but the Father.”

But after His ascension He received from the Father the information the disciples were looking for. Before the close of the first century, while at least one of the disciples was still living, the beloved John, He sent an angel messenger to impart to him and through him to the churches, the information that is “**REVEALED**” in this Book of Revelation. Thus we see that the canon of scripture (standard of church law) would be incomplete without this message from Jesus to His church after His return to heaven.

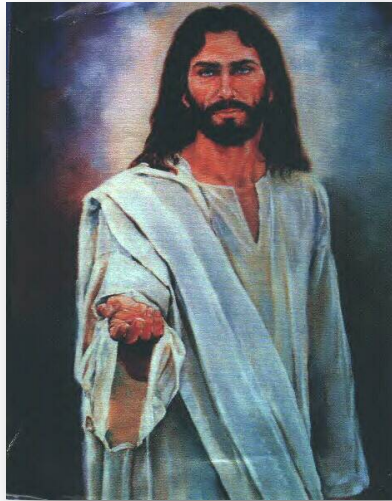
The Book of Revelation differs from all other books, and is incomparably above them, thus revealing its **DIVINE AUTHORSHIP**. In fact it is the only portion of the New Testament to which Jesus gives His endorsement, and affixes His signature, saying at its close, “*I Jesus have sent Mine Angel to testify unto you these things in the Churches.*” Rev. 22:16

The book is a prophetic book, it is not a history. It does not record the past, but reveals the future. It makes this claim in the title:

Revelation 1:3, “Blessed is he that reads and they that hear the words of this prophesy ...”

Within the Book of Revelation we find all unfulfilled prophecy being fulfilled. It is the **FINALITY in PROPHECY** until Jesus comes back. There has been no new revelation since it was written. All those who claim to have received a new or later revelation are imposters and false prophets.

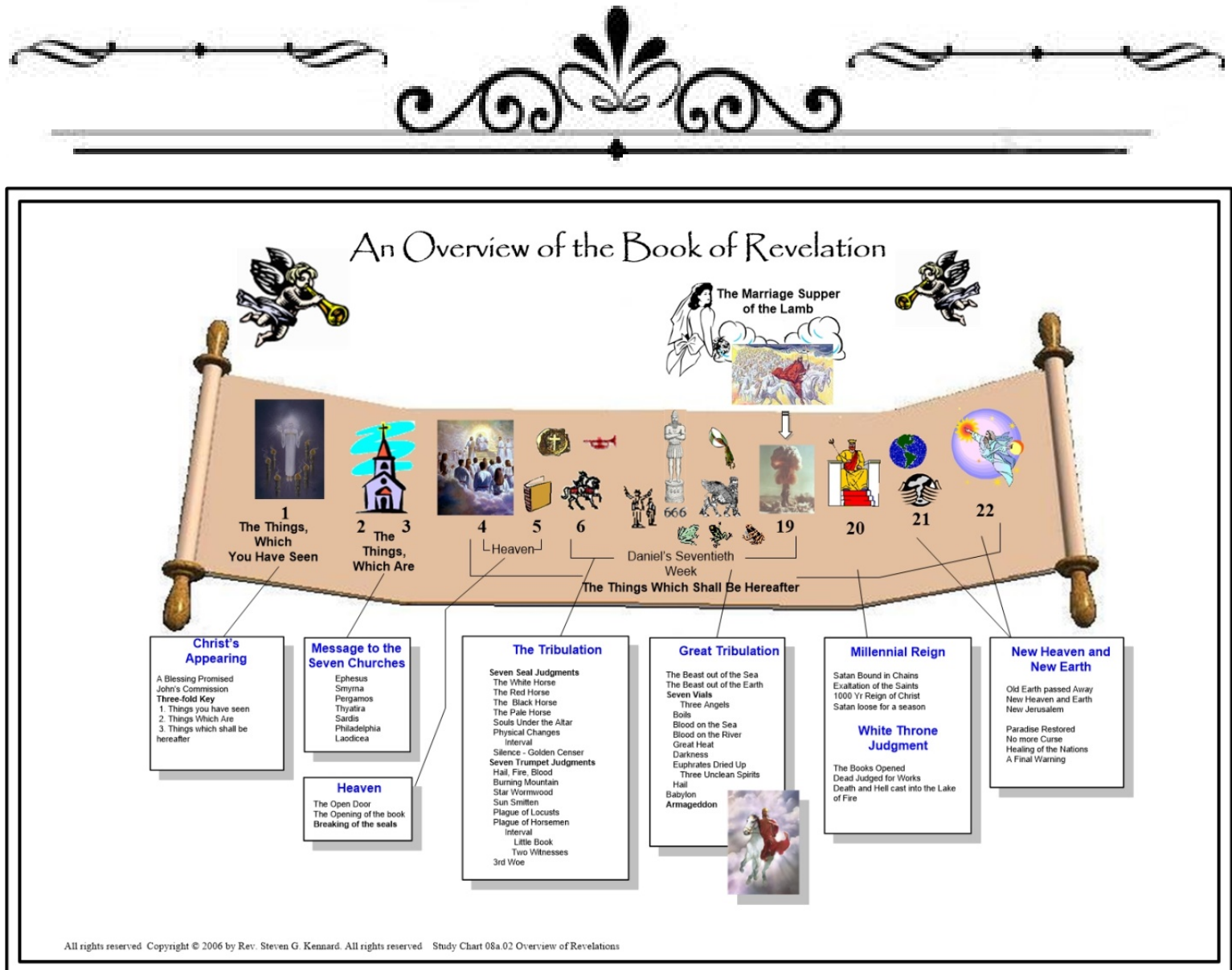
There is no place for “additions” or “subtractions” in the Book. It opens with a “blessing” promised to the reader, and ends with a “curse” upon those who “add unto” or “take from” the book, Rev.1:3; 22:18-19. Nothing is said about understanding the Book, only “Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written in it; for the time is near.”

# THE BOOK OF Revelation



A look at End-Time Eschatology



efore we begin our look into the Book of Revelation I want to present to you the “Key” to understanding the book and it is given to us in Chapter 1:19 (NASB).

“Therefore write the things which you have seen, and the things which are, and the things which will take place after these things.”

Jesus Himself gives to John and to us the key to understanding this message. He divides it up into three groupings. **“The things you have seen.”** This is chapter one of the book, where Jesus presents Himself in all His glory standing in the midst of seven golden candlesticks (the churches) and holding in his right hand seven stars are the pastors of the churches (Chapter 1). Then there is **“The things which are.”** This is in reference to the seven messages He is about to give to John to give to the seven churches in Asia Minor (Chapter 2-3). The last is **“The things which will take place after these things.”** Again Jesus gives us a path as to the order of this prophecy. We serve a God of order and of prophecy.

Revelation 22:16 (NASB), “I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things for the churches. I am the root and the descendant of David, the bright morning star.”

After the visions have been given and all prophecy has been fulfilled, Jesus proclaims to John that the message / prophecy of the book be proclaimed to the churches. A message the church needs to hear.
