Hebrews 6:1-3 “Therefore, leaving the elementary teaching about the Christ, let us press on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God,² of instruction about washings and laying on of hands, and about the resurrection of the dead and eternal judgment.³ And this we will do, if God permits.”



The Bible has so much to tell us that we have missed out on over the years. To all the teachings in scripture there are Mysteries and still unknown stories to be discovered in the Bible to those who spend the time to study, showing themselves approved unto God. And so let us look into one of the better hidden truths of scripture. It is old and yet it is new.

Let me tell you a mystery and it deals with creation and the time before Adam. Now there are basically two Christian views on this subject, the **NEW-WORLD** Creation theory and the **OLD-WORLD** Creation theory. The first one believes that everything was created in six days, but with a since of age to it. Basically, that God created the earth in a state of being very old. The second theory is that God created the earth but over a period of time long before Gen.1:3-31.

Now, just for the record, I am an Old-World Creationist believer. This is the only way that the Bible and scripture fit seamlessly together. The Bible talks about the world that then existed and it has only been through prayer and the study of God’s word that my eyes been opened to new truths in scripture that have been there forever.

One thing I know is true and will always be true. In my 68 years of knowing Jesus as my Savior, I have found that the Bible has always been true in what it tells me. Where there is a difference of opinion then scripture wins out over our personal views. So, I study and like Paul tells says “Leaving the elementary teachings,” for new believers, but then pushing on to Discipleship teaching, rightly dividing the Word of God, as we are led by the Holy Spirit.



Touched By the Hand of God

Genesis 1:1, “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.”

In the first verse of scripture, we find some remarkable pieces of evidence of supernatural authorship. It is here that we find where God tells us of **WHEN**, **WHERE** and **WHAT** He created

- **When:** In the Beginning: [**TIME**] has also been translated “*dateless past*”
- **Where:** The heavens: [**SPACE**] plural, meaning the three heavens,
- **What:** The earth: [**MATTER**] “*erets*,” meaning dry ground, dirt.

Elohim tells us in this very first verse of the scriptures when He created **Time** (endless and eternal), **Space** and the expanse of it and **Matter** the things we can see and touch.

For thousands of years scientists and philosophers have speculated on the makeup of the universe. It wasn't until the twentieth century that physicists confirmed that the universe and its foundation consist of Space and Time. The two of these concepts are so closely linked that astrophysics speaks of a Space-Time Continuum. Science today seeks the knowledge of what was told us in the first verse of scripture over thirty centuries ago.

As an additional note, the “time” we speak of here is not the same as described in Gen.1:3-5. “In the beginning” time is endless and eternal; it has no end. The evening and the morning of v4 were not the first twilight of eternity, but rather for us is a boundary line between time and eternity. Time as we count is temporal, in that it has a beginning (Gen 1:3-5) and will have an end (Rev. 21). It marks a time when Elohim began to create. He did it ... in the beginning (in the Berisheet of time) of the “dateless past.”

Psalm 33:9, “For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast.”

The First Hierarchy

Seraphim – The closest to God, burning with love of God. The burning one with six wings

Cherubim – Radiant with wisdom, guardians of divine mysteries.

Thrones /ofm – Bearers of God's authority and judgment, embodying order and stability.



May I now present to you, what has been on my heart to share, that of the deeper truths, and of the mysteries of scripture ... behold I show you a mystery (1 Cor. 15:51). And there are many in the Bible, and we may not learn the meaning of all of them. What we don't know or understand we take then by faith, because without faith it is impossible to please God (Hebrews 11:6).

So, let's get started where the scriptures begin ... with "In the beginning God created," can anyone tell me how long ago God created according to Genesis 1:1? The Bible has much to say about events that happened in "the world that then existed" (2 Peter 3:6).

Gen. 1:1 (Hebrew text) "Berisheet bara Elohim Alef-Tav (Alpha / Omega) el sha-may-im et el eh-rets

English translation "In the dateless past God the Son brought out of nothing the Heavens and the earth.

Now Jesus tells us in Rev. 22 exactly who He is, and He speaks of Himself as it says in Gen.1:1.

Rev. 1:3, 22:13, "¹³I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end."

In Genesis 1:2 says, "And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

In the Hebrew the word "Heaven" is plural "Heavens" meaning the three heavens, and two more words "form, and void" which in the Hebrew is "*tohu wa-bohu*" meaning it **became** formless and void.,

Isaiah 45:18 (KJV) ¹⁸"For thus saith the Lord that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it **not in vain**, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the Lord; and there is none else." And so, it became inhabited ... but by who?

If we move on to Gen. 1:31 we hear God declaring His work as "Very Good." God certainly wouldn't have called it "very good" if it was formless and void.

And so, the earth of v1 was perfect and complete and it pleased God, a perfect place, a garden place.

THE WORLD BEFORE ... ADAM & EVE



oday I'd like to talk about a time that the scriptures refer to (without directly saying it), as a

“Time Before Time Began.”

Genesis 1:5 (KJV), ⁵ And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.

This is the beginning of the proverbial time clock (roughly 6000 years ago), as we know it, going forward from this point on.

For us, **time** begins at Genesis 1:3-5. This verse becomes a boundary line drawn in the sand, between eternity past, and the Ante-Diluvian Age.¹ As it is said in v5 that the “evening and the morning were the first day,” being one rotation of the earth.

Our study will be focused on the events that took place before this first day and are most certainly pre-Adamic in its scope. This period is the (First of seven ages of God) and it has a name, it is called the “**Creative Age of God**,” the Alpha Age, when God began to create. When God created the world, the universe and everything in it. The **Angelic Host** was already there, they gave to Him praise and worship for the things He had spoken into existence.

Job 38:7, “The morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy.”

These spiritual beings have unique roles and characteristics, but they share a common purpose. Their job is to worship God and minister to His people.

Lucifer was one of God's angels, a magnificent Archangel of God. The Prophet Ezekiel described him for us.

Lucifer was indeed a mighty Archangel and anointed Cherub. He was placed in Eden when God first created it, in the beginning, along with possibly as many as 1/3 of the angel hosts.² God created Eden to be inhabited and here we see when it was first inhabited, as we will read shortly, “before there was a

man on the earth, equals **PRE-ADAMIC**.” Not inhabited by some other form of human beings, but rather angelic in their nature, and like Lucifer ... until sin was found in them also.

A PLACE CALLED EDEN THE GARDEN OF GOD THE PLACE AND ITS INHABITANTS



Who Lucifer Was

Question: **Who was in Eden before Adam and Eve?**

Ezekiel 28:12-15, ¹² “This is what the Lord God says: You had the seal of perfection, full of wisdom and perfect in beauty. ¹³ **You were in Eden, the garden of God**; every precious stone was your covering: The ruby, the topaz and the diamond; The beryl, the onyx and the jasper; the lapis lazuli, the turquoise and the emerald; and the gold, the workmanship of your settings and sockets, was in you. On the day that you were created they were prepared.

¹⁴ You were the anointed cherub who covers, and **I placed you there**. You were on the holy mountain of God; You walked in the midst of the stones of fire. ¹⁵ You were blameless in your ways from the day you were created **until unrighteousness was found in you**.



It is God who answers our question, when He said, “I placed you there,” speaking to Lucifer, and if to Lucifer then all the angels who followed him, hundreds of thousands if not multiple millions. And the Lord put Lucifer and his angels there to inhabit Eden ... and they did!

Scripture speak briefly of Lucifers kingdom and how bad Lucifer was and evil in his trading. We don't know how long all this existed, it was a long, long time. Again, the Bible tells us three times of all that went on was before man was created,

NO MAN!

We find in scriptures that there was a time before Adam, before man existed. The events thereof, I believe happened in Eden the Garden of God, we will get into that later.

To the use of the term “**No Man**” in scripture: A quick search and we can find at least three times that scripture declares to us, “There was no man.” Adam and Eve were both absent from prior events that we will be looking at, but we also don't read of any births in that same time frame either, that doesn't mean that there were other human beings on this earth before them.

Take a look at the 3 times in scripture God tells us of the absence of man

1. Gen. 2:5, “And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for the Lord God had not caused it to rain upon the earth, and there **was not a man to till the ground.**”
2. Job 38:26 (KJV) “To cause it to rain on the earth, where **no man** is; on the wilderness, wherein there is **no man**,”
3. Jermiah 4:25 (KJV) “I beheld, and, lo, there was **no man**, and all the birds of the heavens were fled.”

Truly Adam and Eve were the first **Man** and the first **Woman** that God created. If they were the first, then who is the scriptures talking about? In the next section we will be looking at what I think is the answer to that question and looking into Scriptures in which the events of that day were happening at the “time Before time began,” when there “**was no man**” upon the face of the Earth.

Read what the prophet said about this time of beginnings.

WHO LUCIFER WAS

Of His Beauty and Perfection:

As we are told in Ezekiel's narrative, that Lucifer was the one who served faithfully in God's Kingdom. He was a model of perfection, full of wisdom and beauty. For some period of time in creation past, Lucifer existed as part of God's beautiful perfection. He could not be improved in any way. Every part of him added up to complete wisdom and beauty.

When Lucifer worshiped before the throne, out of his mouth came the sounds of a majestic choir and beautiful music.

Ezekiel 28:13-19, ¹³You were in Eden, the garden of God; every precious stone was your covering: The ruby, the topaz and the diamond; the beryl, the onyx and the jasper; the lapis lazuli, the turquoise and the emerald; and the gold, the workmanship of your settings and sockets, was in you. On the day that you were created they were prepared. ¹⁴ You were the anointed cherub who covers, and I placed you *there*. You were on the holy mountain of God; you walked in the midst of the stones of fire. ¹⁵You were blameless in your ways from the day you were created until unrighteousness was found in you.

It was not necessary for Lucifer to learn to play a musical instrument in order to praise God. He had a built-in pipe organ that was part of who he was. Lucifer did what a musical instrument would do in the hands of a skilled musician. Lucifer didn't have to look for someone to play the organ so that he could sing the doxology... he was the doxology. It is no wonder that when Lucifer fell from grace that one of the first things he perverted was music.

Lucifer was also adorned with precious stones and gold. He was found blameless in all his ways from the very day he was created. This statement testifies to the fact that at least for some period of time he did God's will and all the Kingdom of Heaven was in harmony. There was a time when according to scripture:

Job 38:7, "The morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy."

Lucifer is included in this as a "son of God," a "morning star."



SO WHAT WENT WRONG

Ezekiel 28:15, "You were blameless in your ways from the day you were created until unrighteousness was found in you."

Isaiah 14:12-15 (NKJV), ¹²"How you are fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! *How* you are cut down to the ground, you who **weakened the nations!** ¹³ For you have said in your heart: 'I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation on the farthest sides of the north; ¹⁴I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High.' ¹⁵Yet you shall be brought down to Sheol, to the lowest depths of the Pit.

Ezekiel tells us that sin was found in Lucifer. He does not tell us when this happened, only that it did happen. Let's re-read why Lucifer fell from grace as hard as he did.

1st, He (Lucifer) **Weakened the Nations**, and you might ask, "What Nations?" It was Lucifer who said v13 above, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God. A throne equals a kingdom and a kingdom equals nations. Does not God even sit on His throne, in His kingdom? In his own words Lucifer states his goal, to "exalt his throne above the stars of God. The stars of God are His angels. Lucifer not only wanted to be over the 3rd of the angelic host, but he wanted to be over ALL of them.

2nd, v14, “I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High.” Satan wanted to sit in the place of God, where God sits and rule as God does. All creation would answer only to him, but there is more ...



Ezekiel 28:16-19, ¹⁶By the abundance of your trade you were internally filled with violence, and you sinned; therefore, I have cast you as profane from the mountain of God. And I have destroyed you, you covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire. ¹⁷Your heart was **haughty because of your beauty**; you **corrupted your wisdom** by reason of **your splendor**. I threw you to the ground; I put you before kings, that they may see you. ¹⁸By the **multitude of your wrongdoings**, in the **unrighteousness of your trade** you **profaned your sanctuaries**. Therefore, I have brought fire from the midst of you; it has consumed you, and I have turned you to ashes on the earth in the eyes of all who see you. ¹⁹All who know you among the peoples are appalled at you; you have become terrified and you will cease to be forever.””

I was eagerly looking for more from the Lord, looking everywhere in scripture, then God showed me my answer, where I never thought it would be, because I had never heard this before. So, I think it's time we hear from someone else ... the prophet Jeremiah

WHAT DID JEREMIAH SEE?

One of the first Bible reference I ever found in the Bible was right there in Genesis 1:2 and it pointed me to Jeremiah 4:23 to the time the prophet had a vision of the pre-adamic world. the prophet was a seer and he saw the earth and described it as a “**fruitful place**” v26, (hence Eden the garden), (Remember God says He was the one who put Lucifer in Eden, (Ezek. 28:14), but Jeremiah also saw its destruction taking place. Jeremiah saw that the heavens above had no light. The mountains were quaking being jolted back and forth.

Jeremiah 4:23-28 (NASB), ²³I looked at the earth, and behold, *it was* a **formless and desolate emptiness**; And to the heavens, and **they had no light**. ²⁴I looked on the mountains, and behold, they were quaking, and all the hills jolted back and forth. ²⁵I looked, and behold, there was **no human**, and all the **birds** of the sky had fled. ²⁶I looked, and behold, the fruitful land was a **wilderness**, and all its cities were pulled down Before the Lord, before His fierce anger. ²⁷For this is what the Lord says: “The whole land shall be a **desolation**, Yet I will not execute a complete destruction. ²⁸For this the earth will mourn, And the heavens above will become dark, Because I have spoken, I have purposed, And I have not changed My mind, nor will I turn from it.” (also see Job 9:5-8, Ps. 104:32, Isa 24:1, II Peter 3:3-6)

The Lord God executes a complete judgment on Eden and the waters of the deep became violent and crashed down on the land masses, and the hills and mountains shook and then collapsed into the deepest parts of the sea, the cities and places of worship, all the infrastructure was destroyed by the hand of God. Judgment had come to the kingdom of Lucifer, but God said He would not make a complete destruction v27. All traces of Lucifers actions lay in ruined at the

bottom of earth's oceans. Darkness fell over the kingdom and over Eden, water covered the entire planet, this became the condition of the earth for countless years and Millenniums, the length of time we are not told and will probably never know till we get to heaven.

I believe this was the time of the great Continental Divide in which God pulled the one massive land mass apart and made seven smaller continents,³ and seven great Oceans,⁴ You could look at this as “calling Cards” from God for those who need reminding of who He is.

Now, if we were to compare Jeremiah 4:26-28 above to the Genesis 1:2 account we find that the wording strikes a familiar chord, in its description of the destruction of the Earth and the whole land was made desolate and laid in darkness. I believe that here we find the source of why the earth, after untold years, centuries, maybe even thousands to millions of years (unknown to us) are found exactly as we read it in Gen.1:2. It was made desolate, “*tohu wa-bohu*.”⁵

Since there was “No Man” on the face of the earth, then why would God come down and basically destroy the surface of the earth with strong earthquakes that collapsed the mountain ranges and the tallest peaks on earth be would vanish under the powerful torrents of flood waters that came and covered them all until nothing could be found of their existence again. As man has learned the hard way, down through the centuries, there is only one answer . . . **SIN!**

Question: **Why did the world (Eden) become formless and void?**

The basic answer, which I think we all know, but still must be stated ... because of Lucifers sin, but God in His anger went still further, and God said “I will not make a full end” let's look at what God told Job.

WHAT GOD TOLD JOB

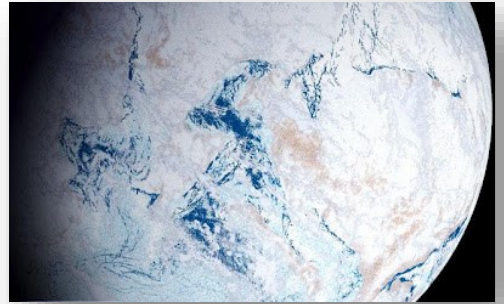
Job 9:5-9, ⁵It is God who removes the mountains, and they do not know how, when He overturns them in His anger. ⁶It is He who shakes the earth from its place, and its pillars tremble; ⁷Who commands the sun not to shine, and puts a seal on the stars; ⁸who alone stretches out the heavens, and tramples down the waves of the sea;

Job 38: 4-11, “Where were you when I laid the foundation of the earth? tell *Me*, if you have understanding, ⁵who set its measurements? Since you know. or who stretched the measuring line over it? ⁶On what were its bases sunk? or who laid its cornerstone, ⁷when the morning stars sang together and all the sons of God shouted for joy? ⁸“Or *who* enclosed the sea with doors when it went out from the womb, bursting forth; ⁹when I made a cloud its garment, and thick darkness its swaddling bands,

¹⁰ and I placed boundaries on it and set a bolt and doors, ¹¹ and I said, ‘As far as this point you shall come, but no farther; and here your proud waves shall stop’?

Job 38: 25-30 (KJV); “²⁵ Who has divided a watercourse for the overflowing of waters, or a way for the lightning of thunder; ²⁶ To cause it to rain on the earth, where no man is; on the wilderness, wherein there is no man; ²⁷ To satisfy the desolate and waste ground; and to cause the bud of the tender herb to spring forth? ²⁸ Has the rain a father? Or who hath begotten the drops of dew? ²⁹ Out of whose womb came the ice? and the hoary frost of heaven, who hath gendered it? ³⁰ The waters are hidden as with a stone, and the face of the deep (abyss) is **FROZEN**.



And so the earth, the Garden of God laid in ruin because of Lucifers sin, God judged the place of sin and it will never be the same for ever more, it all lays over turned at the bottom of the sea under many layers of ancient ground and there it will stay until Revelation 21 and 22 happens ... Rev.21:1 “And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.”

2 Peter 3:5-6 (KJV) ⁵ “For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water: ⁶ Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished:”

Here we find the difference between Lucifers flood and the Flood of Noah. In Noah’s flood the earth was not destroyed, the Ark came to rest on the hills of Mount Ararat.

We find in the **Book of Psalms chapter 104** where the Psalmist himself also speaks of these same events and declares the message to us. Are we listening?

Psalms 104:5-9,30,32, ⁵ “Who laid the foundations of the earth, that it should not be removed forever. ⁶ You covered it with the deep as with a garment: the waters stood above the mountains. ⁷ At your rebuke they fled; at the voice of your thunder, they hasted away. ⁸ They go up by the mountains; they go down by the valleys to the place which you have founded for them. ⁹ You have set a bound that they may not pass over; that they turn not again to cover the earth. ³⁰ You send forth your spirit, they are created: and you renew the face of the earth. ³² He looked upon the earth, and it trembled: he touched the hills, and they smoke.”

The Psalmist proclaims that God rebuked the flood water and in one day they receded, this was not the case with flood waters in Noah’s flood. With Noah’s flood the water took 150 days (Genesis 8:3–4).

Does any of this sound familiar? Sounds like the Psalmist was borrowing from Jerimiah 4, (i.e. I beheld the mountains, and, lo, they trembled, and all the hills moved lightly.)

If you have studied, showing yourself approved of God then know this of the above scripture, that v5 was an act of the original creation Gen.1:1. In v6 from above we see the aftermath of the destruction of Eden buried in the depths of the water and earth Gen.1:2. The results of v7-9 from above can be found in Gen.1:9-10 on the third day of the restoration of the earth.

Does these scriptures and the events they speak of sound like Noah's flood ...NO! The Bible tells us that Noah's flood lasted for 40 days⁶ that the water prevailed on the earth for 150 days⁷ and after that time the waters gradually receded from the earth so that by the 7th month and the 17th day, the Ark came to rest on the mountains of Ararat.⁸ A year and two months and twenty-seven days later the earth was dry enough so that Noah, his family, and the animals could leave the Ark.⁹ Noah's flood did not destroy the earth, it did however kill every man, woman and child, and the Nephilim, the watchers and the Mutinous Angels on the earth except for eight people, Noah and his family. No one died in the Lucifer flood as this event happen before the was a man on the earth. In Genesis 9:15 God promises He will never destroy man again with a flood and gave a sign of His promise ... the Rainbow.



Unlike the Noahic flood, God gives no promises in the above scriptures quoted from Jeremiah, Isaiah, Job and finally Psalms. No sign given in the Lucifer Flood, because God in His righteous anger did literally destroy the land mass with no promises made, as that there was no one there to receive the promise. Science can see evidence of this Judgment, they call it “**Continental Drift.**” In the beginning the earth was one large land mass, but when God finished His judgment on it, it had been torn into 7 parts and moved into new locations forming 7 new continents and 7 new oceans.¹⁰

At this same time, it is written that he “weakened the nations.” Now you may be asking what nations? Let me remind you that within the Kingdom of Heaven there was another kingdom within, and it was ruled over (governorship) by Lucifer. Lucifer ruled over his kingdom and at least one-third of the angels¹¹ were subject to him. A kingdom is also divided up into smaller groups of nations and cities. In this pre-adamic period this kingdom that Lucifer had governorship over had nations and the cities of angelic beings in it. It is to these cities that Jeremiah 4:23-27 speaks to, in the time when God's wrath was poured out.

Lucifer desired to exalt his throne above the “Stars of God” a reference to the other two-thirds of the angels. He wanted to sit upon the “mountain of God.”

Isaiah 14:13-15 “For you have said in your heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: I will ascend above the heights of the clouds:

His mention of the “Mountain of God” is speaking about the government (implies rulership), or the throne of God. Now there is no way to even attempt this without some type of violence or war taking place. For all that Lucifer was given and all that God created good and holy in him, he gave it up in an attempt to be like God and rebelled against his creator and convinced one-third of the angels under him to rebel also.

And with that Lucifer¹² who will now be forever known as **Satan**, the **Devil** (Ma.4:1), **Adversary** (1 Peter 5:8), The **Serpent** (Genesis 3:1), The **Accuser** (Revelation 12:10), **Father of all Lies** (John 8:44). Each of these names reveals different aspects of his character and actions in the spiritual realm.

Lucifer now known as Satan and his many angels were cast out of heaven and onto the earth. Jesus would later comment on this as He says He saw Satan falling to earth like lightning.



Luke 10:18 “And He said to them, “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven.”

So, Lucifer, the once mighty Arch angel and covering cherubim of the Lord was cast out of heaven and one day will not be allowed back into heaven where he still accuses the righteous. He has an appointment waiting for him in a bottomless pit and the Lake of Fire.

Revelation 12:9-11, ⁹ And the great dragon was thrown down, the serpent of old who is called the devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him. ¹⁰ Then I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying,

“Now the salvation, and the power, and the kingdom of our God and the authority of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brothers and sisters has been thrown down, the one who accuses them before our God day and night. ¹¹ And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, and they did not love their life even when faced with death.



Now the earth lays quietly under the oceans of water completely destroyed as God said He was going to do (Jer. 4:26-28). And to seal its fate God tells Job that He froze the waters down to the very lowest parts of the abyss, and complete darkness fell onto the earth, and so it was and it happened “in the **Dateless Past**,” before there was a man on the earth.

Restoration

Genesis 1:2, ² And the earth was a formless and desolate emptiness, and darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters.



Psalms 104:5-9,30,32, ⁵“Who laid the foundations of the earth, that it should not be removed forever. ⁶ You covered it with the deep as with a garment: the waters stood above the mountains. ⁷At your rebuke they fled; at the voice of your thunder, they hasted away. ⁸ They go up by the mountains; they go down by the valleys to the place which you have founded for them. ⁹ You have set a bound that they may not pass over; that they turn not again to cover the earth. ³⁰ You send forth your spirit, they are created: and you renew the face of the earth. ³² He looked upon the earth, and it trembled: he touched the hills, and they smoke.”

The Psalmist proclaims that God rebuked the flood water and in one day they receded, this was not the case with flood waters in Noah’s flood. With Noah’s flood the water took 150 days (Genesis 8:3–4).

Genesis 1:2: And the earth was a formless and desolate emptiness, and darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters. ³ Then God said, “Let there be light”; and there was light. ⁴ God saw that the light was good; and God separated the

light from the darkness. ⁵ God called the light “day,” and the darkness He called “night.” And there was evening and there was morning, one day.



Titus 1:2: (KJV) ² In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;



Ezekiel 1:4-21, ⁴ As I looked, behold, a high wind was coming from the north, a great cloud with fire flashing intermittently and a bright light around it, and in its midst *something* like gleaming metal in the midst of the fire. ⁵ And within it there were figures resembling four living beings. And this was their appearance: they had human form. ⁶ Each of them had four faces and four wings. ⁷ Their legs were straight and their feet were like a calf's hoof, and they sparkled like polished bronze. ⁸ Under their wings on their four sides *were* human hands. As for the faces and wings of the four of them,

⁹ their wings touched one another; *their faces* did not turn when they moved, each went straight forward. ¹⁰ As for the form of their faces, *each had* a human face; all four had the face of a lion on the right and the face of a bull on the left, and all four had the face of an eagle. ¹¹ Such were their faces. Their wings were spread out above; each had two touching another *being*, and two covering their bodies. ¹² And each went straight forward; wherever the spirit was about to go, they would go, without turning as they went. ¹³ In the midst of the living beings there was something that looked like burning coals of fire, like torches moving among the living beings. The fire was bright, and lightning was flashing from the fire. ¹⁴ And the living beings ran back and forth like bolts of lightning.

¹⁵ Now as I looked at the living beings, behold, there was one wheel on the ground beside the living beings, for each of the four of them. ¹⁶ The appearance of the wheels and their workmanship was like sparkling topaz, and all four of them had the same form, their appearance and workmanship being as if one wheel were within another. ¹⁷ Whenever they moved, they moved in any of their four directions without turning as they moved. ¹⁸ As for their rims, they were high and awesome, and the rims of all four of them were covered with eyes all around. ¹⁹ Whenever the living beings moved, the wheels moved with them. And whenever the living beings rose from the earth, the wheels rose also. ²⁰ Wherever the spirit was about to go, they would go in that direction. And the wheels rose just as they did; for the spirit of the living beings was in the wheels. ²¹ Whenever those went, they went; and whenever those stopped, they stopped. And whenever those rose from the earth, the wheels rose just as they did; for the spirit of the living beings was in the wheels.
